

ORDINANCE NO. 61

SOLICITORS AND CANVASSERS

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Gifford, Champaign County, Illinois, that:

Section I

It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in business as a canvasser or solicitor, calling at residences without the previous consent of the occupant for the purpose of soliciting orders, sales, subscriptions, or business of any kind, or seeking for information or donations without first having registered in the office of the village clerk. The registrant shall give his complete identification, his signature, the name of his employer, the nature of the products or services in which he is interested, the names of the manufacturers of such products, or of the organization which he is representing, and the proposed method of operation in the village.

Section II

Each registrant shall pay to the village clerk a registration fee of two dollars for the period expiring ninety days after the date of said registration.

Section III

Each applicant who shows evidence of good character and who pays the fee provided for herein shall be furnished a certificate indicating that he or she has registered and showing the dates covered by such registration.

Each person shall at all times while soliciting or canvassing in the village carry upon his person the registration certificate and the same shall be exhibited by such registrant whenever he is required to do so by any village marshal or by any person solicited.

Section IV

The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to officers or employees of the village, county, state or federal government, or any subdivision thereof, when on official business.

Section V

Any such registration may be revoked by the president or the village marshal because of any violation by the registrant of this ordinance or of any other ordinance of the village, or of any state or federal law, or whenever the registrant shall cease to possess the qualifications and character required in this ordinance for the original registration.

Section VI

The practice of going in and upon private residences in the village by solicitors, peddlers, hawkers, itinerant merchants, or transient vendors of merchandise, not having been requested or invited so to do by the owner or owners, occupant or occupants of said private residences, for the purpose of soliciting orders for the sale of goods, wares and merchandise, and/or for the purpose of disposing of and/or peddling or hawking the same, is declared to be a nuisance.

Section VII

Any person who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance or commits any nuisance as defined in this ordinance shall be fined not less than three dollars nor more than two hundred dollars for each offense.

Section VIII

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

Gifford, Illinois, who
fails to obtain such
license as herein
provided shall be
guilty of a misdemeanor.
