

ORDINANCE NO. 173

LEVY AND ASSESSMENT OF TAXES FOR THE
CURRENT FISCAL YEAR

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Gifford, Champaign County, Illinois, did on the 1st day of April, 1982, pass the Annual Appropriation Bill for said Village for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 1982 and ending March 31, 1983, the amount of which is ascertained to be the aggregate sum of \$211,650.00, which said Appropriation Bill was duly published on April 10, 1982 ;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Gifford, Illinois:

SECTION I

That there be and is hereby levied upon all taxable property within the corporate limits of the Village of Gifford, Illinois, subject to taxation for the year 1982, the total sum of \$186,450.00 for the following specific purposes mentioned in said Appropriation Bill and in the respective sums as follows:

MAINTENANCE ENGINEERING TO BE PERFORMED BY A CONSULTING ENGINEER
(To be attached to Municipal Estimate of Maintenance Costs, form BLR 591)

The services to be performed by the engineer, pertaining to the various items of work included in the estimated cost of maintenance operations, on form BLR 591, shall consist of the items checked below:

PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING shall include:

Investigation of the condition of the streets; determination (in consultation with the municipal officials) of the maintenance operations to be included in the maintenance program; preparation of the maintenance resolution, estimate and proposal attending such meetings of the governing body as may reasonably be required; attending the public letting and preparing the contract or acceptance of proposal forms; and the preparation of the maintenance expenditure statement.

ENGINEERING SUPERVISION shall include:

Furnishing the engineering field supervision (including preparation of payment estimates or checking material invoices) of those special maintenance operations requiring professional supervision, as opposed to those ordinary operations such as street sweeping, snow removal, tree trimming, crack filling, cleaning ditches and culverts, etc., which require no professional supervision.

For furnishing these services the engineer will be paid in accordance with the following schedule of fees. The fee for Preliminary Engineering shall be applied to the total estimated cost of all maintenance operations included in the maintenance estimate except Maintenance Engineering. The fee for Engineering Supervision shall be applied to the final total cost of those maintenance operations to be supervised by the engineer. Ten percent of the total fee will be withheld until such time as the expenditure statement is submitted and the final cost of supervised items is known.

NOTE: Should the maintenance estimate be revised after it is once approved or if the final supervised maintenance cost varies from the estimated cost, sufficiently to change the percentage bracket, a new schedule must be submitted.

SPECIAL PROVISION
FOR
FAIR EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES

In addition to all other labor requirements set forth in this proposal and in the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, adopted by the Department of Transportation on July 1, 1976, during the performance of this contract, the contractor for itself, its assignees, and successors in interest (hereinafter referred to as the "contractor") agrees as follows:

I. SELECTION OF LABOR

The Contractor shall comply with all Illinois statutes pertaining to the selection of labor.

II. EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

During the performance of this contract, the contractor agrees as follows:

(1) That it will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, color, religion, sex, national origin or ancestry; and further that it will examine all job classifications to determine if minority persons or women are underutilized and will take appropriate affirmative action to rectify any such underutilization.

(2) That, if it hires additional employees in order to perform this contract or any portion hereof, it will determine the availability of minorities and women in the area(s) from which it may reasonably recruit and it will hire for each job classification for which employees are hired in such a way that minorities and women are not underutilized.

(3) That, in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by it or on its behalf, it will state that all applicants will be afforded equal opportunity without discrimination because of race, color, religion, sex, national origin or ancestry.

(4) That it will send to each labor organization or representative of workers with which it has or is bound by a collective bargaining or other agreement or understanding, a notice advising such labor organization or representative of the contractor's obligations under the Illinois Fair Employment Practices Act and the Commission's Rules and Regulations for Public Contracts. If any such labor organization or representative fails or refuses to cooperate with the contractor in its efforts to comply with such Act and Rules and Regulations, the


