

ORDINANCE NO. 199

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF NEW STREET

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF GIFFORD, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

That portion of New Street lying north of the Illinois Central Railroad right-of-way described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot 3 of Hylbert's Replat of Block 5 of the Original Town of Gifford, thence due North on the West line of Lots 1, 2 and 3 238.90 feet to a point being the Northwest corner of Lot 1; thence continuing on North 80 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot 4 of the Original Town of Gifford and continuing on North along the West line and the West line extended of said Block 4 a total of 240.5 feet to the North line of North Street; thence West 66 feet to a point; thence due South along the East line of Lot 1 of Sawdey West and Old's Addition 536 feet to the Southeast corner of the said Lot 1; thence Southeasterly on a straight line approximately 75 feet to the point of beginning, situated in the Village of Gifford, Champaign County, Illinois,

is hereby vacated.

Section II

This ordinance was adopted on July 3, 1986, 4 trustees voting aye and 0 trustees voting nay, the same being atleast 3/4 of the trustees then holding office in said Village.
