This new license shall authorize the sale on Sundays not before 12:00 noon and ending not later than 12:00 midnight of the same day, the sale of any alcoholic beverage to be consumed on the premises where sold. The fee for such license shall be the sum of \$125.00 semi-annually (six months), or \$250.00, for a full year of Sunday license, payable in advance for each six-month period which fee shall accompany the application for such license which application shall be in such form as the Village President from time to time may require.
