## ordinance no. 243

## AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTING PARKING LIMITATIONS DURING SNOW REMOVAL

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF GIFFORD, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: PARKING LIMITATIONS DURING SNOW REMOVAL. It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle on any public street in the Village at any time after a snowfall of two (2) inches or more has occurred until the street has been plowed clear of snow. Said parking limitations shall be as follows:

- A. Said limitation shall be in effect on all streets where there is posted a sign designating said street as a snow route. All such streets shall have posted, in each block affected and in each direction, not less than one such sign designating the same as a snow route.
- B. Village employees seeking to enforce the parking limitation after or during a snowfall of two inches or more shall make reasonable efforts to notify the owners of illegally parked vehicles prior to towing the same. Inquiry at the home or business in front of which the offending vehicle is parked shall constitute reasonable efforts to notify. After such effort, the illegally parked vehicle shall be to towed and it shall be the owners' responsibility to retrieve said vehicle after paying to the Village the costs it incurred to tow the vehicle.

SECTION II: Except as herein provided all other provisions of the Ordinances for the Village of Gifford shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication, as provided by law.
