## ORDINANCE NO. <u>252</u>

WHEREAS, the Board of the village of Gifford, Illinois, did on the 3rd day of August, 2000, pass an annual appropriation Ordinance for the Village for the fiscal year beginning on the day of April 2000, the aggregate amount of which is ascertained to be in the sum of FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY-EIGHT THOUSAND AND FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY DOLLARS AND no/100ths (\$558,460.00).
