

ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR CONTROL OF ANIMALS

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Gifford, Illinois:

Section 1. No person shall cruelly treat any animal in the Village in any way; any person who inhumanely beats, under-feeds, overloads, or abandons any animal shall be deemed guilty of a violation of this section.

Section 2. DISEASED ANIMALS. No domestic animal afflicted with a contagious or infectious disease shall be allowed to run at large, or to be exposed in any public place whereby the health of man or beast may be affected.

Section 3. MUZZLES. Whenever the President of the Village Board by proclamation shall declare that danger from rabies is great, it shall be unlawful to permit any dog to go upon any public street, alley, or sidewalk or other public place unless such dog is securely muzzled.

Section 4. INOCULATION. It shall be unlawful to keep or harbor in the Village any dog which has not been inoculated or vaccinated against rabies within the year.

Section 5. PENALTY. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any provision of this article shall be fined not less than one dollar nor more than twenty-five dollars for each offense.
