ORDINANCE NO. 39

ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS

EXCEPT BY OFFICERS IN PERFORMANCE OF DUTY

OR BY A CITIZEN LAWFULLY DEFENDING HIS PERSON OR PROPERTY

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Gifford, Illinois:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to discharge any firearms or airgun in the village; provided, that this section shall not be construed to prohibit any officer of the law to discharge a firearm in the performance of his duty; nor to any citizen to discharge a firearm when lawfully defending his person or property.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this article shall be fined not less than one dollar (\$1.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be published in manner and form as is provided by law, by publishing the same in some newspaper of general circulation within the Village of Gifford, such publication to be made within ten (10) days after the passage and approval of this Ordinance.

 $\underline{\text{Section 4.}}$ This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its publication as herein provided and as provided by law.
