

ORDINANCE NO. 46

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DEFACING OR
DAMAGING OF VILLAGE PROPERTY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF GIFFORD, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to wilfully or negligently damage, break, deface, destroy or injure in any manner whatsoever any property of any kind or nature, wherever located, belonging to or owned by the Village of Gifford, including but not limited to sidewalks, streets, curbs, pavements, alleys, trees, manhole covers, buildings, meter wells, water tower and any other property belonging to the Village of Gifford not specifically named herein.

Section 2. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any provisions of this article shall be fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$200.00 for each offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

Section 3. The Clerk shall certify to the passage and approval of this Ordinance and cause the same to be published in pamphlet form.

Section 4. This Ordinance is declared to be urgent and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and shall therefore take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, signing and publication as required by law.
