

SCAVENGERS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Gifford, Illinois:

Section I

LICENSE REQUIRED: It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to engage in the business of scavenger, or the collection or disposal of animal, vegetable refuse or offal without having first secured a permit therefor. The annual fee for such permit shall be One Dollars (\$ 1.00).

Section II

APPLICATIONS: Applications for such permits shall be made to the Village Clerk and shall by such Clerk by referred to the President and Board of Trustees; no such permit shall be issued except on order of the President and Board of Trustees.

Section III

VEHICLES: ~~Any vehicle used by any person, firm or corporation in the business of scavenging or the collection or disposal of animal, vegetable refuse or offal shall be subject to the following regulations:~~
~~It shall be unlawful for any such vehicle to be driven over or through any street in the Village during or on a Sunday.~~
It shall be unlawful for any such vehicle to be driven over or through any street in the Village during or on a Sunday.

Section IV

DISPOSAL: It shall be unlawful for any scavenger to dispose of or store any refuse in any place in the Village limits, or within one mile thereof, excepting with the permission of the President and Board of Trustees.
