ORDINANCE NO. 70

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE KEEPING OF ANIMALS AND POULTRY IN THE VILLAGE OF GIFFORD, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF GIFFORD, ILLINOIS:

SECTION I

STRAYS: It shall be unlawful to permit any cattle, hogs, swine, sheep, goats or poultry to run at large in the village.

SECTION II

SWINE: It shall be unlawful to keep or have any line swine or hogs anywhere in the village.

SECTION III

GOATS: It shall be unlawful to keep or have any goats anywhere in the village.

SECTION IV

CATTLE, POULTRY: It shall be unlawful to keep or have any cattle or chickens or other poultry within one hundred and fifty (150) feet of any residence other than the residence of the person so keeping or having such animals, chickens or poultry anywhere in the village.

SECTION V

HOUSE AND YARD: No person shall keep or allow any stable, building, shed, yard or place where any animal or poultry is or may be kept to become unclean or unwholesome anywhere in the village.

SECTION VI

NOISES: It shall be unlawful to harbor and keep any animals or poultry which disturb the peace by loud noises any time of the day or night.

SECTION VII

PENALTY: Whoever violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$200.00.
