

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF GIFFORD, ILLINOIS:

# SECTION I

It shall be unlawful to keep or have any animal other than household pets anywhere in the Village within one hundred (100) feet of any dwelling other than the dwelling of the person so keeping or having such animal.

### SECTION II

Every person shall maintain an animal yard or animal place in a clean, sightly and sanitary condition and shall regularly clean and remove all refuse, debris, feces or manure, which shall be kept in covered containers and regularly disposed of.

## SECTION III

It shall be unlawful to harbor or keep any animal which disturbs the peace by loud noise at any time of the day or night.

#### SECTION IV

The keeping or having of any animal, other than household pets, anywhere in the Village within one hundred (100) feet of any dwelling other than the dwelling of the person so keeping or having such animal, is hereby declared to be a nuisance and is prohibited. The keeping of any animal which disturbs the peace by loud noise at any time of the day or night is hereby declared to be a nuisance and is prohibited.

### SECTION V

Whoever violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$200.00.

# SECTION VI

This ordinance shall take effect from and after its presentation, approval, signing and publication as required by law.
