## ORDINANCE NO. 89 1967 ELECTION ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF GIFFORD, ILLINOIS, THAT:

#### SECTION I

There shall be a regular election of officers in the Village of Gifford, Illinois on the 18th day of April, 1967.

#### SECTION II

At such election there shall be elected a Village President, a Village Clerk and three (3) Village Trustees for a four (4) year term. The ballot to be used in such election shall be in the form prescribed by statute, and it shall be the duty of the Village Clerk to see to the preparation of sufficient ballots for the election, and to cause a sample of such ballot to be published prior to the day of election in a newspaper of general circulation published in the Village at least five (5) days before said election, and to provide the necessary election supplies.

#### SECTION III

At least fifteen (15) but not more than thirty (30) days before the election the Clerk shall cause to be published in such newspaper a notice of election, which shall be substantially as follows:

#### NOTICE OF ELECTION

On the 18th day of April, 1967 there will be a regular election in the Village of Gifford to elect a Village President, a Village  $\overline{\text{Clerk}}$  and three (3) Village Trustees for a four (4) year term.

The entire Village of Gifford shall constitute the sole election precinct and the polling place for such election shall be the Gifford Water Department Building at 104 East Center Street, Gifford, Illinois.

Polls shall be opened from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. CST.

#### SECTION IV

The voting precinct for such election and the polling place shall be that designated in the preceding Section.

#### SECTION V

The judges of the election shall be such as shall be designated by the President and Board of Trustees to serve as election officials.

### SECTION VI

The said election and all matters pertaining thereto shall be conducted in the manner prescribed by statute for the conduct of a regular election for Village officers.
