

ORDINANCE NO. 97

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF  
PERSONAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Village of Gifford, Illinois, an Illinois municipal corporation, is the owner of a certain 1962 half-ton Ford pick-up truck and that the President and Board of Trustees of said Village do hereby find that the retention of said truck by said Village is no longer necessary or useful to or for the best interests of the city or village and that the sale, as herein provided, of said truck best serves the interests of said Village.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Gifford, Illinois, that:

SECTION 1.

The Clerk is hereby directed to advertise the proposed sale of the 1962 Ford half-ton pick-up truck owned by the municipality by giving notice hereof in a newspaper of general circulation in said county, published once.

SECTION 2.

Any proposed purchaser shall make an offer in writing setting forth the price in cash such purchaser is willing to pay for said vehicle and enclose a certified check in the amount of 10% of said purchaser's bid and seal the same in an envelope to be delivered to the President or Clerk of the Village not later than 7:00 o'clock p.m. on March 21, 1968. The minimum acceptable bid shall not be less than \$500.00.

SECTION 3.

On March 21, 1968 at the hour of 7:00 o'clock p.m. the President and Clerk of the Village shall open all bids received, in the municipal building in Gifford, Illinois, and the President is hereby authorized to award

the sale herein to the highest and best bidder for cash and is further authorized to reject any and all bids.

SECTION 4.

The President and Clerk are hereby authorized to do such acts as may be necessary or convenient to consummate the proposed sale of said truck as above-provided, including the transfer of title.
