

ORDINANCE NO. 122

FAIR EMPLOYMENT ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF GIFFORD, ILLINOIS:


It is hereby declared to be in the best interests of
the Village of Gifford to help insure that no supplier or con-
tractor dealing with the Village deny employment to any person
on the basis of race, color, or creed.

SECTION I: Each supplier or contractor dealing with
the Village of Gifford shall not deny or refuse employment to
any person on the basis of race, color or creed.

SECTION II: At the time such supplier or contractor
enters into a contractual relationship with the Village of
Gifford, such supplier or contractor shall then deliver to the
Village a declaration in writing that throughout the term of
the contract such supplier or contractor will not deny or refuse
employment to any person on the basis of race, color or creed;
and, before final payment may be made under the contract by the
Village, such supplier or contractor shall deliver to the Village
a written declaration that such supplier or contractor has
complied with the requirements of this Ordinance.

SECTION III: Whoever violates any provision of this
Ordinance shall be fined not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars. A
separate offense shall be deemed to have been committed each
day a violation continues.
