

ORDINANCE NO. 151

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF GIFFORD:

Section I

Premises within the Village of Gifford to which municipally owned water services have been furnished or sewerage services furnished and for which service or services the Village has not been timely paid is and are hereby declared to be the obligation of the owner of such premises to pay within 10 days of the demand that such payment be made and the same shall be promptly on demand paid by said owner of such premises.

Section II

If such delinquent bill as afore-described is not paid as above-required, such municipal service shall be terminated to such premises and not restored until written application for such restoration is made by such owner to the municipal authorities and accompanying such application a deposit in cash, certified check, bank draft or bank money order a bond to guarantee future payment of services in an amount equal to three months average services and the payment of such delinquent sum in full.

Section III

Nothing in this ordinance shall prohibit the Village of Gifford from proceeding to enforce any delinquent sum for such municipal service directly against the owner of such premises in a court of law.
