

ORDINANCE NO. 161

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING
THE STORAGE OF BUILDING MATERIALS
ON RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY UNDER CIRCUMSTANCES
GIVING RISE TO A NUISANCE

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Gifford, Illinois, that:

SECTION 1.

It shall be unlawful to store, keep or maintain upon any residential premises lumber, cement blocks, shingles or any other construction materials or supplies except those reasonably necessary respecting construction activity either in process or within a reasonable period of time ~~before~~ ^{after} construction activity has ended. (11/2)

SECTION 2.

It shall be unlawful to store, keep or maintain upon any residential premises lumber, cement blocks, shingles or any other construction materials or supplies except for use respecting construction activity in process or proposed on the premises where the same are stored, kept or maintained.

SECTION 3.

Any violation of this ordinance shall constitute the maintenance of a nuisance which this corporate authority hereby declares to be a violation of the public's health, welfare and safety.

SECTION 4.

A violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 and a separate offense shall be deemed to have been committed each day a violation occurs.

ADOPTED by the Board of Trustees and the Mayor who approved the same, of the Village of Gifford, Champaign County, Illinois, this 6th day of November, 1980.


