ORDINANCE NO. 116

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NEW RATES FOR WATER SYSTEM

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Gifford, Illinois, as follows:

That Ordinance No. 154 is hereby repealed and a new Section 9 of Ordinance No. 40 adopted October 5, 1962, is hereby adopted as follows:

Section 9. The following shall be the rates for water supplied through the waterworks system of said Village. Water bills will be rendered monthly with meters read monthly about the twentieth day of the month.

For a customer whose property is located within the Village of Gifford municipal limts, for the first 3,000 gallons per month, \$5.50 per month minimum; and, for a customer whose property is located outside of the Village of Gifford municipal limits the first 3,000 gallons per month, \$11.00 minimum;

For	the next 7,000 gallons per month per 1,000 gallons;	\$ 1.30
For	the next 15,000 gallons per month per 1,000 gallons;	1.00
For	the next 25,000 gallons per month per 1,000 gallons;	.65
For	all over 50,000 gallons per month per 1,000 gallons;	.50

The minimum monthly charge for users of the services of the waterworks system of the Village, shall be based upon the size of the water meter installed at the request of the user and shall be as follows:

For each 5/8 inch meter - \$ 5.50 per month;

For each 1 inch meter - \$ 9.00 per month;

For each $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch meter - \$20.00 per month; and

For each 2 inch meter - \$30.00 per month;

and provided further that a separate minimum charge shall be made for each apartment, flat, place of business or family unit in all buildings containing two or more apartments, flats, places of business or family units; but, provided further no minimum charge shall be made for any vacant apartment, flat, or place of business in any such building which said apartment, flat or business is vacant during an entire month.
