

ORDINANCE NO. 200

AN ORDINANCE PERMITTING THE LIMITED
SALE OF LIQUOR ON SUNDAY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF GIFFORD, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The holder of a Class A regular retailers license for the payment of an additional fee of \$35.00 for each 6-month period shall be permitted to sell alcoholic liquor in packages for consumption off the premises where sold on Sunday from noon until midnight.

Section II

The holder of a Class B license issued to a not-for-profit organization for an additional fee of \$35.00 for each 6-month period shall be permitted to sell beer only in packages for consumption off the premises where sold on Sunday from noon until midnight.

Section III

The holder of a license permitting the sale of package beer and package wine only for consumption off the premises where sold for an additional fee of \$35.00 for each 6-month period shall be permitted to sell package beer and package wine only for consumption off the premises where sold on Sunday from noon until midnight.

Section IV

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and signing as required by law.
