SUNDAY LIQUOR LICENSE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF GIFFORD, ILLINOIS:

Section I


There is hereby created a new class of liquor license and it is the intention of this municipality to modify its presently pre-existing liquor ordinances to provide for such new license.

Section II

The Village President is hereby authorized to issue a Sunday only liquor license for the sale of any alcoholic beverage, ~~to be consumed on the premises where sold~~ when sold by a holder of a pre-existing daily license issued by this municipality. This new license shall authorize the sale on Sundays not before 12:00 noon and ending not later than 12:00 midnight of the same day, ~~the sale of any alcoholic beverage, to be consumed on the premises where sold.~~ The fee for such license shall be the sum of \$125.00 semi-annually (six months), or \$250.00, for a full year of Sunday license, payable in advance for each six-month period which fee shall accompany the application for such license which application shall be in such form as the Village President from time to time may require.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and signing as provided by law.
