## ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NEW RATES FOR WATER SYSTEM

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Gifford, Illinois, as follows:

That Ordimance No. 191 is hereby repealed, and Section 9 of Ordinance No. 40 adopted October 5, 1962, is amended as follows:

Section 9. The following shall be the rates for water supplies through the waterworks system of said Village. Water bills will be rendered monthly with meters read monthly about the  $20^{4\nu}$  day of the month.

For a customer whose property is located within the Village of Gifford municipal limits, for the first 3,000 gallons per month, \$7.50 per month minimum; and, for a customer whose property is located outside of the Village of Gifford municipal limits the first 3,000 gallons per month, \$\pmu(1.00)\$ minimum;

For	the next 7,000 gallons per month per 1,000 gallons;	\$ 2.00	
For	the next 15,000.00 gallons per month per 1,000 gallons;	1.80	
For	the next 25,000 gallons per month per 1,000 gallons;	1,50	
For	all over 50,000 gallons per month per 1,000 gallons;	1.00	

The minimum monthly charge for users of the services of the waterworks system of the Village, shall be based upon the size of the water meter installed at the request of the user and shall be as follows: each apartment, flat, place of business or family unit in all business or family unit in all buildings containing two or more apartments, flats, places of business or family units; but, provided further no minimum charge shall be made for any vacant apartment, flat, or place of business in any such building which said apartment, flat or business is vacant during an entire month.

In order for a customer to obtain water from the Village of Gifford, he must first pay a connection fee of \$\sum\_{150.00}\$ for the privilege of connecting on to the Village of Gifford water system. The water meter installed shall remain the property of the Village of Gifford, and the customer shall pay all costs of connecting to the Village system.

In addition to the foregoing rates there shall be charged to the Village of Gifford, Champaign County, Illinois, the sum of \$\frac{\pi}{200000}\$per year for fire hydrantsconnected to the Village system for fire protection.

The Village reserves the right to make such reasonable changes in rates and in conditions herein established and to establish further rules and regulations from time to time as may be found expeditious or necessary.
